


Today it is estimated that the Sensory Processing Disorder (SPD) affects approximately 3% of children.












Manual & machine

Different experiments have shown that the sense of touch is as important as sight to learn and retain information. It is also known that tactile activities help children improve from mathematical skills to reasoning abilities.





